Students have come from all over PNG, nations outside PNG, a range of Christian denominations, the secular field and private sectors within PNG.

BITC is working in partnership with Vision International University (VIU) so we can offer accredited Certificate and Diploma level courses to our students.

FRONTIER EVANGELISM INSTITUTE

Certificate in Evangelism and Church Planting

Frontier Evangelism Institute (FEI) is a full-time, live-in course that is designed to prepare and equip men and women to be effective in evangelism and church planting.

FEI is for those who feel a divine calling to frontier evangelism and pioneering new churches. It is for those who are hungry to reach the lost, and have a passion to do whatever it takes to reach people for Christ.

A priority of FEI is to provide effective training on the 'how to' of evangelism, planting a church and pioneering new works (both theoretically and practically).

This course is designed to develop the character of each individual. Students will be challenged to grow in the areas of self-motivation, submission, obedience, servanthood and integrity.

Students will receive excellent teaching from the experienced pastors and lecturers at BITC, as well as from international ministries.

At the end of the course students will have an understanding of the part they play in God's plan and know how to share the Word with others.

<u>Some</u> of the subjects covered in this course include:

- Church Planting
- Frontier Evangelism Teams
- Teamwork

- The Four Cs of Evangelism
- How to Pray for the Sick
- Helping Young Leaders to Emerge

Upon completion of FEI, students will receive an accredited Certificate in Evangelism and Church Planting.

Students will then be able to complete further study in World Missions Faith Training School (pages 6-7) or Bethel Bible College (pages 8-9).

Throughout their course, students will have regular opportunities to engage in evangelistic outreach, open airs and ministry in the local community.

Students will also experience a period of practical ministry expression. They will be given the opportunity to go as a team to engage in pioneer work in a provincial area.

Students will be based at BITC in Tokarara, Port Moresby for the duration of their course. Meals and accommodation are included in the fees.

WORLD MISSIONS FAITH TRAINING SCHOOL

Certificate in Missiology

World Missions Faith Training School (WMFTS) is a full-time, live-in course that is designed to prepare and equip men and women to become missionaries and to promote missions in their local church.

WMFTS is for those who have a desire to see world missions take a more prominent place within their own lives and the life of their local church.

Servanthood, submission and faith are essential to effective missionary service and are the major characteristics we seek to develop in the students' lives.

This course is designed to present students with a balanced presentation of Biblical truths in practical ways, and to encourage their burden and passion for missions to continually develop.

At the end of the course students will have an understanding of the needs of the worldwide missions movement, and the knowledge needed to build missions-based support groups in the home and local church.

<u>Some</u> of the subjects covered in this course include:

- Jesus the Missionary
- Five Keys of Authority
- Why I Believe in Missions
- Servanthood
- Sacrifice
- Nations for Christ (Revelation of God's Heart for the Nations)
- In Pursuit of Freedom (Praying for the Bound)

Upon completion of WMFTS, students will receive an accredited Certificate in Missiology.

If they desire to continue their study at BITC, students will have an opportunity to enrol in Frontier Evangelism Institute (pages 4-5) or Bethel Bible College (pages 8-9).

Throughout their course, students will have regular opportunities to engage in practical ministry in the local community through participating in outreach and open air events.

Students will also experience a period of practical ministry expression. They will be given the opportunity to go to a village as a team to conduct ministry and outreach within the local community.

Students will be based at BITC in Tokarara, Port Moresby for the duration of their course. Meals and accommodation are included in the course fees.

BETHEL BIBLE COLLEGE

Diploma in Theology and Ministry

Bethel Bible College (BBC) is a full-time, live-in course that provides men and women with a unique opportunity for specialised study and preparation for ministry.

BBC is designed for those who have a desire to enhance their Biblical studies and ministry preparation.

Since its commencement in 1984, BBC has trained men and women from all over Papua New Guinea, from other Pacific Island nations, India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, the Philippines, United States of America, Indonesia, Australia and more.

Students will receive excellent teaching from the experienced pastors and lecturers at Bethel International Training College (BITC), as well as from international ministries.

When students and lecturers come from different countries to participate, the unique environment of cross-cultural relationships provides an ideal setting for active discipleship training.

<u>Some</u> of the subjects covered in this course include:

- Hermeneutics (How to Study the Bible)
- New Creation Realities
- Pastoral Shepherding
- Pneumatology (The Holy Spirit)
- Pastoral Ministry
- Diving Healing
- Leadership Dynamics
- Duty of Care of Children

All students <u>MUST</u> complete a Certificate in Evangelism and Church Planting from Frontier Evangelism Institute (pages 4-5) or a Certificate in Missiology from World Missions Faith Training School (pages 6-7) before they can enrol in BBC.

If you are a graduate of World Missions Faith Training School but you did not receive a Certificate of Missiology, please contact BITC as you may still be eligible to enrol in BBC (contact details on page 15).

Upon completion of BBC, students will receive an accredited Diploma in Theology and Ministry.

BBC provides opportunities for practical ministry experience both in the local church and in a village setting.

Students will be based at BITC in Tokarara, Port Moresby for the duration of their course. Meals and accommodation are included in the course fees.

BETHEL PRESCHOOL TEACHER TRAINING COLLEGE

Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care

Bethel Preschool Teacher Training College (BPTTC) is a full-time, livein course that provides men and women with the necessary training to become accredited preschool teachers.

BPTTC is for those who identify a personal call to work with children and who recognise the important role access to quality education plays in the lifelong development of children.

The goal of this course is to minister the gospel to children for their spiritual development and future lives so they will grow up to be sound and productive men and women who can make a positive contribution into their societies.

BPTTC has a heart for the nations and is open to missions-minded preschool teachers of all nations.

<u>Some</u> of the subjects covered in this course include:

- Children's Health, Safety and Wellbeing
- Occupational Health and Safety In an ECE Setting
- Recognising and Responding to Children at Risk
- Working Legally and Ethically
- Cultural Diversity and Professional Practice
- Developing a Play Curriculum to Foster Learning and Development

Upon completion of BPTTC, students will receive an accredited Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care.

Towards the end of their course, students will be given an opportunity to put what they have learnt into practice. They will be required to partake in a practical component where they will go as a team to engage in children's ministry and preschool teaching in a local community.

Upon graduation, interested teachers will have the opportunity to start a preschool in a village or remote/rural area of Papua New Guinea, as well as other nations.

There will also be opportunities for students to gain further practical experience in an existing preschool if they wish to enhance their teacher training.

Students will be based at BITC in Tokarara, Port Moresby for the duration of their course. Meals and accommodation are included in the fees.

BPTTC is open to students from all denominations who specifically want to be trained in developing children.
